These matters came up for hearing before the Commission on the ground that the respondent SPIO has not furnished information despite the directions of the First Appellate Authority (henceforth called FAA). Since, the subject matter of the sought information is same and the information has been sought from the respondents of the same public authority, hence the Commission decided to club both the appeals avoiding multiple proceedings.

2. Shri Raj Kumar represented the appellant. He submitted that the appellant had addressed two RTI applications dated 09.02.2018 to the
7008 and 7011 of 2018

SPIO-cum-Superintendent, Estate Office-I and the SPIO-cum-Superintendent, Estate Office-II, HSVP, Gurugram and requested to furnish following information pertaining to their offices:—

- (i) Total seats in Private Schools remain empty for EWS, BPL students during academic session 2016-2017.
- (ii) Total seats in Private Schools remain empty for EWS, BPL students during academic session 2017-2018.
- (iii) Further to question No. (i) and (ii), total seats given to General Category out of the quota of EWS, BPL Category.

The respondent SPIOs did not furnish information within the stipulated period. Therefore, first appeals dated 18.04.2018 and 19.04.2018, in each case respectively, were preferred with the FAA-cum-Administrator, HSVP, Gurugram. The FAA disposed of the appeal on 08.05.2018 directing the respondent SPIOs to furnish information within ten days. Aggrieved by the non-receipt of any response from the SPIOs, second appeals dated 15.07.2018 and 18.07.2018 have been filed with the Commission to seek intervention. Taking cognizance, the Commission issued notice dated 12.09.2018 directing the respondent SPIOs to submit comments latest by 10.10.2018 and to be personally present before the Commission on the date fixed for hearing. The representative of the appellant submitted that sought information is yet to be received from both the respondent SPIOs. He submitted that he had sought information in public interest and in order to extend benefit of Government scheme to vulnerable sections

of the society and requested to direct the concerned SPIOs to furnish the requisite information without any further delay.

3. Shri Ram Kumar, Deputy Superintendent represented the respondent SPIO-cum-Estate Officer-I and submitted his comments dated 20.11.2018 which are taken on record. The respondent SPIO submitted that appellant's RTI application was received on 13.02.2018. The contents of information sought were perused and found that it is not being maintained in the office of the answering respondent in compiled manner. Accordingly, the appellant was informed vide letter dated 05.07.2018.

4. Shri Suresh Chander, Assistant represented the SPIO-cum-Estate Officer-II submitted that response to RTI application dated 09.02.2018 is yet to be furnished to the appellant.

5. The Commission notes with concern that the FAA in the present case, failed to exercise the quasi judicial powers since the preferred first appeals dated 18.04.2018 and 19.04.2018 remained unattended with him. The FAA, being a quasi judicial body, should have gone into aspects like whether the SPIO has provided reply or not and whether the information is permissible under the provision of the Act etc. while disposing of the appeal. The Commission, therefore, cautions the FAA, to strictly follow the RTI Act and Rules while disposing of appeals and pass a speaking order, after taking due cognizance of the merits of each case.

6. The Commission carefully considered the matter and perused the record available in case file. The averments submitted by the representative of the respondent-SPIO have been noted. Appellant while submitting second appeals in the Commission has agitated non-furnishing of information which he had sought vide RTI application dated 09.02.2018 submitted with the SPIO-cum-Estate Officer-I and SPIO-cum-Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram. He further agitated that the respondent SPIOs are violating provision made in Section 4 of the Act. The Commission noted the submissions made by the respondent-SPIOs that information sought is not readily available to share with the appellant. The Commission during hearing appellant's appeal case no. 2978 of 2017 on 08.06.2017 perused the terms and conditions on which the land was allotted to establish schools in the jurisdiction of Estate Officer-I and Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram. A copy of allotment letter dated 12.04.2007 was perused. Clause 23 and Clause 24 of the allotment letter reads as under:

Clause 23-*"the Education Societies/institutions/trusts should reserve 10% seats in the School for students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society and the same fee will charged from students as it charged by Government Schools and the fee structure will have to be got approved from the competent authority. Further, 10% seats in the schools should also be reserved for those students in respect of whom the fee will be determined on the basis of means and merit of individual case".*

Clause 24- *"the management committee of the school shall have one representative of HUDA as its member".*

The Commission, in this regard, has perused the provision made in sub section (a) of Section 4 (1) of the Act which provides that every public authority shall —

(a) *"maintain all its records duly catalogued and indexed in a manner and the form which facilitates the right to information under this Act and ensure that all records that are appropriate to be computerized are, within a reasonable time and subject to availability of resources, computerized and connected through a network all over the country on different systems so that access to such records is facilitated";*

Further, Section 4 (1) (b) mandates to publish within one hundred and twenty days from the enactment of this Act,—

X X

(xii) *"the manner of execution of subsidy programmes, including the amounts allocated and the details of beneficiaries of such programmes;*

(xiii) *particulars of recipients of concessions, permits or authorizations granted by it".*

X X

The preamble to the Act declares the object sought to be achieved by the RTI Act thus:

"An Act to provide for setting out the practical regime of right to information for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities, in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority, -----

-----And whereas democracy requires an informed citizenry and transparency of information which are vital to its functioning and also to contain corruption



and to hold Government and their instrumentalities accountable to the governed -----

RTI Act was enacted in order to ensure smoother, greater and more effective access to information and provide an effective framework for effectuating the right of information recognized under Article 19 of the Constitution.

Hon'ble Apex Court in Kochuni vs. State of Madras and Kerala, (1960) 2 SCA 412 has held that preamble is a key to the understanding of the Act as under:

"The preamble of a statute is 'a key to the understanding of it' and it may legitimately be consulted to solve an ambiguity which may have more than one, or to keep the effect of the statute within its real scope, whenever the enacting part is in any of these respects open to doubt."

Though the words used in Section 4 (1) (xii) are manner of execution of subsidy programmes yet in view of legal position cited above, the Commission is of the opinion that such like welfare schemes prepared by the State Government is also covered under Section 4 (1) (xii) of the RTI Act and must be published.

In view of the terms and conditions settled with the trusts/organizations/societies/companies etc. while allotting land for establishing educational institutional, the public authority is bound to ensure that such like scheme prepared by the State Government for students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society of

Haryana is well disseminated to all concerned for its proper implementation and welfare of such deprived sections of society.

The Commission observes that above reproduced provisions of Section 4 of RTI Act, 2005 and the preamble of the Act binds the public authority through its authorized officer to make aware the citizens, through wide publicity of the settled terms and conditions on which land was allotted to enable vulnerable sections of the society to get the benefit of the seats reserved for them. It is also required to upload these terms and conditions alongwith the admissions given to the students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society in each academic session on the website to meet the requirement of Section 4 (1) (xiii) of the Act.

The Commission observes that if the managements of the private schools are reluctant in providing information and the benefit for which they agreed according to terms and conditions of allotment, the public authority has vested powers with the Estate Officer who is the SPIO as well to take action against such schools in accordance with the provisions of allotment letter/HUDA Act. The public authority has made the Estate Officer a member in the management committee of the schools to represent HUDA and to ensure the delivery of benefit to the vulnerable sections of the society as per the terms of allotment of land.

6. In view of the above findings, the Commission in exercise of powers under Section 25 (5) of the RTI Act, 2005, in larger public interest recommends as under:

- (i) The public authority i.e. Chief Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula to put the names of institutions and terms & conditions on which the land was allotted to them on its website for the information of general public.
- (ii) It should be ensure that the schools must also prominently display the details of the scheme in the premises of the school at prominent place and at admission counters.
- (iii) The public authority i.e. Chief Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula through the Estate Officers of jurisdiction shall ensure that information about the scheme and admissions given to the students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society and meritorious students in each academic session should be uploaded on the website of the school concerned to whom the HUDA has allotted land. It is also to be ensured that the information of the current academic session must be uploaded on the school's website by 31.01.2019 positively.
- (iv) It is recommended under section 25 (5) of the RTI Act that the Chief Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula may consider working out a mechanism jointly with the Director General, School/Elementary Education, Haryana or any other competent and concerned authority of the State Government for implementation of the terms and conditions of allotment of land.
- (v) The SPIO-cum-Estate Officer-I and the SPIO-cum-Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram shall after obtaining information from all the schools concerned shall share the

information with the appellant by giving specific point-wise reply to the RTI application but not later than two months of the receipt of this order. The respondent SPIO shall compile information about the admissions given to the students belonging to economically weaker sections and meritorious students of the society in the schools for the current academic year i.e. 2018-2019 as well and immediately after the completion of the admission process of each academic year. The information should immediately be uploaded on the website of the public authority so that it could be accessed by the public without exercising their right to information.

- (vi) In case the trust/organization/societies/companies do not abide by the terms and conditions of allotment of land, the Estate Officer-I and the SPIO-cum-Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram may consider taking further necessary action against the Schools as per Law, Rules and terms of the agreement.
- (vii) In case the appellant does not receive information from the respondent SPIO or is not satisfied with the response received, he is at liberty to approach the respondent SPIO by filing rejoinder with a copy to the Commission but not later than two weeks from the receipt of information.
- (viii) The respondent-SPIO shall remove the deficiency spelt out by the appellant in his rejoinder by furnishing further information to the appellant within next two weeks with a copy to the Commission.
- (ix) The compliance report in this regard be submitted so as to reach the Commission's Secretariat by 15.02.2019.



7. The Commission's Secretariat is directed to send a copy of the order to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government Haryana, Education Department and the Principal Secretary to Government Haryana, Town & Country Planning Department for necessary action.

8. The Commission's Secretariat shall retain copy of the order in appeal case file 7008 and 7011 of 2018 for record.





1. ✓ Sh. Manoj Kumar Karwasra originally belonging to village Kirdhan Tehsil & Distt Fatehabad, Presently resident of 612, Navdeep Colony, Hisar was appointed as Physical Education Teacher on contract basis in this school on 14.07.2003 on the basis of his C.V. as he assured to submit the relevant documents at his earliest. The service of the said teacher were terminated on 17.09.2005 because of not making available his academic and vocational certificates as per his promise and because of intolerable behavior. (Pl see Annexure I)
2. Since then feeling aggrieved and disgruntled from the above termination he has been lodging baseless complaints and flooding RTI's against this school vindictively to settle personal score & manipulating the facts in dilated form cunningly, times & again to derive benefit's under this act by seeking various types of information related to this school and its management to the various department like Education, HUDA, CBSE, Police, Registrar of Societies, EPF, ESI, CCS HAU etc. against this school, otherwise he had no complaint against us while he was in service with us.

The frippery , frivolous, time and resource consuming, infructuous, harassing, defaming vexatious and blackmailing with enmity motive based RTI's which have been

abusive and harassing us since last 7 years as if he has lifelong enmity with us.

That with the passage of time and information received from different headquarters/Depts. it has been found that he was earlier terminated as a teacher from Holy Angle School, Hisar because of having bad character being cheating, incorrigible, bluffing, misguiding and befooling etc. (Pl see Annex - II)

Since 2006 Mr. Manoj Kumar Karwasra has been misutilising this progressive act and flooding RTI's on the same/similar topics to different authorities by revolving them again & even their decision have been taken by the competent authorities.

I. **To settle personal score by making target this school:-** Since he was terminated from the school for misconduct, indiscipline, unpalatable behaviour and willful absence and non submission of his qualification documents, he wants to teach a lesson to this school revengefully and flooded this school with indiscriminate efforts to secure various information with least public interest and to use RTI as a tool for vendetta against this school. The case of Mr. Manoj Kumar is a case of personal grudge for redressal of personal grievances which is against RTI Act. (Pl see case of Mahendra Jha V/s Deptt. Of Post F.No. CIC/MA/C/2008/00259) decided on 03.07.2008 (Annexure - III). So far he has sent several RTI's in different names on different occasion by dilating the information.

II. **This use of RTI Provision for own safty:-** He is facing four civil court cases in various courts at Hisar/Fathebad and wants to use the information collected through RTI's to put up in court for redressal. In a similar case CIC in case of Subu Kuriakose (No. CIC/OK/A/2006/00485 dt. 21.02.2007) recorded observation that appellant has tried to misuse the RTI provision by flooding the organization with RTI and seeking voluminous information. In the similar fashion Mr. Manoj Kumar is doing with this school (Annex - IV). In a similar case the CIC cautioned Mr. Madan Lal Mirg observing that the information seeker cannot use resources of public authority to built up an arguable case for him self to put up before legal forum (Pl. see Annux -V) abusing the RTI system to different officer/institutions. So, far he has put up a large number of RTI against this school. Some of them were applied with invalid BPL Cards for which FIR has been lodged against him in all he put up 23 RTI's (Annexure VI) on similar topic to D.E.O., Hisar mostly seeking voluminous information.

III. **Similarly he has submitted a large no. of RTI's to CBSE, New Delhi. against this school CIC asked that it is unaided school and do not fall under RTI Act. (Annex -**

In the similar fashion Mr. Manoj Kumar is doing with this school (Annex - IV). In a similar case the CIC cautioned Mr. Madan Lal Mirg observing that the information seeker cannot use resources of public authority to built up an arguable case for him self to put up before legal forum (Pl. see Annux -V) abusing the RTI system to different officer/institutions. So, far he has put up a large number of RTI against this school. Some of them were applied with invalid BPL Cards for which FIR has been lodged against him in all he put up 27 RTI's (Annexure VI) on similar topic to D.E.O., Hisar mostly seeking voluminous information.
- II. **Similarly he has submitted a large no. of RTI's to CBSE, New Delhi. against this school CIC asked that it is unaided school and do not fall under RTI Act. (Annex -**

- V). After that he started writing the same questions to Distt Education Officer, Hisar (PI see Annexure - VII). Even he submitted a complaint with all possible maximum questions already replied to him more than once which is a clear cut case of indiscriminate efforts to secure information and is abusing, harassment and misutilization of RTI and other resources at command.
- IV. He also asked several question against the present President of St. Sophia Education Society Hisar a renowned National Awardee scientist by Agril. Minister, Govt. Of India. from his work place of service i.e. Haryana Agriculture University to harass and defame him and HAU authorities and misutilization of various resources
- V. Being a disgruntled employee of this school and habitual complainant he has used the RTI as a tool for vindicate against this school to the ridiculous length of 7 years (from 2006 till date) to take benefit of RTI act and is making mockery of it. He has been seeking the similar information under the backdoor to blackmail us for some procedural lacunae to use it in court cases for redressal relating to service matter which is beyond Section 2(f) & (j) (CIC Decision No. 4556/IC(A)2009 F.No. CIC/ORIC/2008/00726 dated 30.Sept. 2009) and CIC Decision No. 835/IC(A)/2007 F.No. CIC Pb/(A)/2007/00198 dated 12, June.2007. (Annexure - VIII)
- VI. Thus he has been moving frivolous & vexatious and fake application using dialating language/information for seeking information about the school from various authorities since 2006 even in the name of ficticious BPL card holders namely Mr. Jeet Ram and his brother Mr. Jai Singh S/o Sh. Kumbha Ram, FIR has been lodged against him in two cases for abetting with Mr. Jeet Ram and Mr. Jai Singh for submitting RTI's on fictitious BPL Cards and to save RTI fees unlawfully. Thus he has cheated SIC/CIC through this action and hence deserve some heavy penalty and recovery of the RTI fees. thus saved (CIC No. 4577/IC/(A)2009 F.No. CIC/AT/C/2008/000356 dated 1 Oct. 2009.

Sir, Rule 113 & 115 of Sec. 19 of RTI Act 2005 (Annexure - IX) dwells that The foregoing explanation about harassing the public authorities the issue is whether asking for diverse thus saved information on the part of applicant does in any way fulfill the objectives of the Act as laid down in the preamble of the act, which is against the Sec. 19 rule 113 (Annex - X) CIC in case of Ms Rachna Sharma F.No. CIC/AT/A/2006/00391 observed that repeated questions are more aimed at settling score. (Annex XI)

He has been submitting identical RTI's to various authorities time and again on the same topic with dilated statements. He has been asking frequent questions regarding his termination, pay EPF etc. for which a public authority cannot be obliged to engage him

for the benefit of an applicant . it is not open to saddle a public authority with elaborate queries about past action. Section 7(9) clearly forbids it. (CIC/AT/A/2008/No.396 dated 1 Oct. 2008) (CIC F.No. AT/A/2006/00062 dated 1, May 2006) (Annex XII)

He is working against universal Declaration of Human Rights, 1948 which reads as Article 19 – “Every citizen has the right of freedom of opinion and expression, this right includes freedom to hold opinions without interference and to seek, receive and in port information and ideas through any media”. He is constantly hammering and interfering our day to day activity, encroaching on our teaching time and other resources which is against the Law. (Ref. write petition 20182 of 2008) Appellant has no larger public interest in support to his excessive use of RTI (CIC/OK/C/2007/00362 & 367) CIC F. No. 08/92 & 174 CIC Appeal No. 2076-77 dated 28, May, 2008. It is worst use of RTI. (Annex XIII)

Already discussed facts proves that Mr. Manoj Kumar has been trying to obstruct the working of one of the best school of Hisar and to create hurdle against the school and has destroyed our peace of mind which is continuously affecting efficiency and is indirectly affecting in the excellence of its students and staff. Thus he has been using RTI to oppress and humiliate us continuously since last seven years.

The Apex Court in Civil Appeal No. 6454 of 2011 CBSE & others have ruled that Act should not be misused or abuse as a tool to obstruct the national development integration or to destroy the peace, tranquility & harmony among its citizen. Nor it should be converted in to a tool of oppression or intimidation of honest officials striving to do their duty to do fructuous exercise. (Annex- XIV)

As explained above. The nation does not want a scenario, where 75% the staff of public authorities spend 75% their time in collecting & supplying information to applicant instead sharing their regular duty. The Apex court noted regarding the scope of the RTI Act and the safe guards and conditions subject to which ‘Information’ should be

show cause notice issued against her. Dr. D.S. Rana, President, St. Sophia Education Society, Hisar & Advocate Anurag Jain reiterated that they are not a Public authority and thus not obliged to furnish information under the RTI Act, 2005, however, they have joined proceedings of the Commission on every occasion, as has been, brought out during the interim orders of the Commission dated 5.08.2013. Advocate Anurag Jain pleaded that appellant had personal vendetta against school and this appeal is required to be dismissed in view of decision of the Hon. Supreme Court in Appeal Case No. 6454 of 2011 in CBSE Vs. Aditya Bandopadhyay and others and by Central Information Commission's orders dated 21.02.2007 in case of Sabu Kuriakose Vs. National Council of Educational Research and Training, New Delhi.

Decision:

On careful perusal of the case file and hearing the respondents present and after taking into account the submissions made, in writing, before the Commission by the appellant and the latest submission submitted by him on 15.10.2013, the Commission has considered the matter carefully. The case was earlier heard and Second Appeal decided on 18.11.2011. Approval for the Show Cause Notice under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 accorded and the same was issued on 18.10.2012. Dates of hearing were fixed and heard on 18.10.2012, 19.12.2012, 21.01.2013 & 30.04.2013 by my other colleague Sh. Sajjan Singh and the matter was heard by this Commission on 5.08.2013 and interim orders passed on the day and the case is finally heard today. The Commission has noted that information was sought from the school which was not a Public Authority and available information with the Public Authority, i.e., SPIO-cum-Deputy District Education Officer, Hisar and CBSE has since been



provided to the appellant. Commission has further noted that Commission had earlier noted while passing orders in respect of appeal Case No. 2063 and 1378 that appellant had personal vendetta to settle scores against St. Sophia Senior Secondary School, Hisar where he was working as a teacher and later on dismissed. This is evident from filing 22 RTI applications to seek information about the same school and detailed submissions made by the Advocate Sh. Anurag Jain in response to another Appeal No. 1378 of 2009 issued against the school before this Commission which need to be repeated here.

Commission has taken a serious view of his vindictive attitude as the RTI Appeal is meant for genuine information seekers to fulfil the objectives set out in the preamble of the RTI Act and not to settle personal scores either with the individuals or with the department where the appellant had worked earlier. Since available information has been furnished by the District Education Officer, Hisar & CBSE, Show Cause Notice No. 165 of 2012 and 126 of 2012 in Case No. 2572 of 2010 issued against SPIO-cum-Deputy District Education Officer, Hisar is hereby filed. As regards show cause notice issued against Principal, St. Sophia Senior Secondary School, Hisar, it is not tenable as the school is not a Public Authority, hence the same is also filed.
